in this examination of the political economy of economic policy determination and evolution in developing countries anne krueger provides concrete insights into the interaction of economic and political variables that determine the success or failure of such policies an understanding that is essential if economists are to provide realistic technical assistance in the formulation of economic policy reform programs the debt crisis of the 1980s accompanied an era of slow economic growth developing countries had widely divergent experiences some like the east asian countries weathered the recession to resume and even accelerate growth and to lower their debt servicing ratios others like those in africa and latin america fell into slow or even negative growth were unable to tighten their debt burden and experienced declines in per capita income krueger analyzes the interaction of politics and economics in experience with slow growth and debt crisis in terms of three major themes the first is that politically determined policies have economic consequences that can and do change the political equilibrium that generated those

policies second the analysis of the political economy of economic policy determination in developed countries can only be undertaken on the basis of assumptions about the nature of government these two themes which have been taken up in current economics and political science literature imply yet a third and less frequently noted proposition that neither economic policies or governments can be looked at as enduring phenomena both the nature of the government and the economic policies can be changed according to the political and economic responses one sets off in the other resulting in various types of policy cycles that need to be better understood

in eight parallel analytical histories of the automobile steel semiconductor lumber wheat and textile and apparel industries the contributors demonstrate that trade barriers rarely have unequivocal benefits and may indeed be counterproductive in the long run they also find that the political and administrative criteria for awarding protection do not take into account the interests of final consumers other american industries or foreign countries

the political economy of bureaucracy applies public choice theory and a complex systems view of government institutions to analyze policy implementation as an economic process it addresses the common and vexing question of why managing federal agencies for results is so difficult by challenging traditional assumptions of institutional design and policy analysis using creative methods that focus on relationships that constrain the choices of executives and managers in a political hierarchy the author reveals control and coordination as goals that are imperfectly achieved and often conflicting with one another despite decades of intense study serious reform efforts and impressive technological advances the u s government remains a typical bureaucracy that fails to meet citizens expectations clearly policy analysis is missing something the problem may rest with machine models of government rules especially those governing expenditures are assumed to be feasible and effective analysis of the federal government as a complex system of relationships between semi autonomous agents helps explain the disconnect between policy and results the solution is to roll back micro management of ends and means policymakers should focus on objectives and facilitate implementation by selectively relaxing constraints that prevent experimentation needed to determine the most effective methods this book devotes unusual attention to the interaction between executive and legislative branches of government and between political appointees and career civil servants most studies of government policy take existing institutional structure for granted different conclusions emerge from this analysis by virtue of the systems view that accepts status quo hierarchies but questions the effectiveness of the rules that govern policy implementation this book will be of interest to postgraduates and researchers focussing on economic theory public choice institutional economics and political science as well as to those working in the public sector interested in public administration public policy and organizational behavior

activity in this paper it is argued that a tendency toward increasing complexity of controls is probably inherent in most efforts to regulate and that the great likelihood that it will occur should be taken into account in initial policy formulation economic policy analyses may be correct as formulated on the assumption that the initial policies will be adopted and not be altered but be wrong if it is recognized that increased complexity may be an inevitable cost of the policy
